

FAT SHEEP & LAMB SALE – 30TH APRIL 2024

Glen Innes Selling agents penned 1340 head comprising 470 lambs, 173 hoggets and 697 sheep.

Processors were keen to compete on the better finished lambs, especially trade weights, resulting in significant price rises of \$10-\$20 per head. Once again a lot of secondary, unfinished lambs penned with most returning to the paddock. Hoggets with weight topped @ \$90, whilst the best dorpers reached \$142.20 est. 22.5kg dressed.
